### Our Goal/Mission

The Leadership Victor Valley Program is designed to develop dedicated and knowledgeable men and women as community leaders. Our purpose is to enhance awareness of community needs and concerns and to afford access to community leaders, gaining first-hand experience, knowledge and encouragement for greater business and community growth. Our goal is to provide the Victor Valley with a cadre of those who not only have demonstrated leadership, but who will likely assume greater or more detailed leadership roles in the future.

### The Format

Each class is designed to inform, motivate and challenge the participant. Community leaders design each session to present issues from various perspectives through the use of panels, tours and individual presentations. Participants are given the opportunity to discuss how those issues might be resolved.

### \$650 Full-Course Graduation Requirements

Participants are expected to attend all six core classes, two of four electives, and to prepare for the topic by completing pre-requisites as assigned. Classes will be held from 7:45 am - 12:00 pm. Participants missing any of the required sessions will not graduate with the present class. Sessions can be made up in subsequent years (not to exceed 2 years). Cost includes all required programs and materials, including a graduation recognition dinner.

### \$90 Quick-Start Requirements

Participants may select as many core classes and electives as they choose and receive credit toward graduation. Quick-Start is designed for leaders who desire a more individual program. Cost is per class and includes materials.
